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



CRYSTAIS are incredibly versatile and beneficial! They resonate with energy, showcasing characteristics that are signature to each stone. Some promote positive aspects, like love or courage. Others alleviate negative energy, such as anxiety or hot-headedness. Several contain unusual attributes such as vivid dreaming or luck. The possibilities are nigh endless!

When it comes to the same category of crystal (amethyst for example) each individual crystal will radiate its own unique energy. In other words, all amethysts will exude a general calming effect, but one amethyst will resonate with some individuals better than others. This can be due to several factors, such as size, shape, whether it is polished or raw, and coloring patterns. Just like



humans and snowflakes (which are crystalline in nature), no two amethysts are exactly alike. This is one of the major reasons I advocate for people to pick their own crystals.

To do so, you'll want to find a metaphysical store, and borrow one of their books to research while you shop (or study online beforehand.) I know this is easier said than done – the closest shop to me is over an hour away. However, it is significantly better than ordering crystals online and letting a stranger pick them for you.

Once you've determined which crystals suit your purpose (ex: Tiger Eye for courage) then you'll find the container and begin sifting your hand through the crystals.

Focus intently on how they feel. Do any of the individual stones stand out or arrest your attention? Hold those and inspect them from all angles. Once you feel as though you've found a proper match, trust your instincts – that crystal is resonating with you on a personal level.

After your crystal claims you, you'll need to bring it home and cleanse it. It's been in the shop for who

knows how long, drawing in other people's energies. You'll want to attune this crystal to your energy. Most crystals can be rinsed in clean running water - otherwise, burn sage and let the smoke cleanse them. The next step is to charge it – yes, like a battery. Set the crystal in a windowsill overnight, so that it absorbs lunar energy.

Sometimes your crystals will feel dull or lifeless. This is a sign that it has absorbed too much negativity or burnt out of energy. For as long as you're utilizing crystals, you'll need to cleanse and charge them for routine maintenance, to keep them (and you) healthy. I cleanse and charge my crystals once a month, though it varies per individual and their given circumstances.

Crystals usually perform best when they are within close proximity to you for an extended period of time. You can wear the crystal by placing it in a pouch and carrying it in your pocket, though some are crafted into jewelry. You can keep it on your desk at work, or perhaps under your pillow while you sleep at night. Whenever you need it, hold it close and meditate on its purpose.

A: Honestly, health issues that came up brought me back to my voice.


I deal with severe neurological issues and chronic fatigue that have recently left me in a wheelchair on good days, and bed-bound on many other days. It's a

progressive illness that started a few years back, but we didn't notice what was happening until it got really bad.

I'm still on a journey of discovering just what is going on, and have no idea what my long-term health outlook is right now. So I've decided to just follow my dreams and do something I've always wanted to do—make music. Never in my wildest dreams did I think I would get so far.

Q: Is there a particular message you want to convey with your music?

A: Yes, absolutely. The world that we see—that I see—around us right now is filled with hate and despair. Transgender folks like myself are discriminated against, harassed, and even attacked on a daily basis. Black folks like myself are killed by the people who are supposed to protect them. Immigrants like myself are locked away in camps and separated from their families for trying to make a new life for themselves and escape conflict.

But we don't need to live like this. We can change this narrative for the better. Through my work, I want to showcase the joy in the lives of people like myself and show others that things can be better. And I want to bring to light these issues and point people towards concrete decisions and actions that they can take to protect us.

Q: What is your favorite song on your album? What was the inspiration for the song?

A: This is not an easy question! I love each song for many different reasons, but I Won't Go definitely resonates with me on a different level.

The song addresses the journey with my health that I have had to deal with over the course of this year. But even more unique, two days after writing and singing the lyrics, I found myself needing emergency surgery in the hospital. I was intubated and hospitalized for a little over a week.

After surgery, I actually took my phone out and recorded the hospital equipment attached to my body. You can hear that equipment in the song, panned to the same positions that they were in from my perspective. This song will forever be associated with those events.

Q: Who are your musical influences? Why do you idolize them?

A: There are too many to list here! When it comes to style, I take inspiration from almost every artist I hear.

Honestly a big influence of mine isn't any specific musical artist, but The Burgundy Room, an in-game dance troupe and venue that I lead. We've performed countless times over the past few years, covering a wide range of work. It has surrounded me in a creative and artistic environment that has heavily influenced me, and encouraged me to pursue music and make original works.

Q: What was the first song you sang in public?

A: In my choir days, I honestly couldn't tell you. It's been so long since then. Other than that, it would actually have to be Spark!

Q: Words of wisdom for someone getting into a career?

A: That sounds cliché, sure, but it's true! Worry less about how others perceive your work and dive into what you want to do until you can do it really

freaking well. Then search relentlessly for opportunities.

Q: Best advice you ever got?

A: Musically, the most important piece of advice I got was to not micromanage my creativity. Part of the journey of making music is to trust yourself, even if just a little bit. I've been performing for a few years now, but putting your work out there and showing others your art is always scary! Once you get past that stage, the

creative freedom is wonderful.



Since this house is a Free Company House too, they have turned all the members chambers into games for visitors to compete in. These games are given difficulty numbers using stars. Five stars seem to be the maximum difficulty, with one star being the lowest.

The tutorial shows that the puzzles take advantage



of glitches in the game. By placing decorations perfectly, you can jump into the void, and here in the void the house designer(s)

have placed platforms and objects anywhere they wish to provide platforming puzzles. Using other commands like /doze and /sit, these puzzles use all kinds of tricks to provide a fun but challenging task.

Each room gets more and more challenging, and the smallest mistake be it jumping too early or too late or even walking too far can result in falling to square one.

I decided to check out one of their hardest rooms, and I couldn't even get off the first platform. It involves a perfect jump, using paleton or sprint, and jumping at the right spot but no matter how much I tried I couldn't make it.

Honestly this house looks incredible, and I'm sure the creators of these puzzles are very happy with what they've made as they should be. While not something I am good at, these platforming puzzles are a joy, and hopefully they can get more visitors who can find a lot of entertainment from this.

Q&A with the Owner:

Q: Tell our readers a little about "Game" and where you drew your inspiration from?

A: Galactic Circus <GAME> is one of the newest play hubs for our international jump puzzle community, known as Strange Housing. We're a collection of builders and players worldwide who are always looking for a new place to get together and do some crazy stuff in!



Far from being the first to exist, Galactic Circus draws inspiration from other puzzle hubs in hope of mixing in some unique ideas

and style to create the ultimate hangout spot to

bring friends and have an awesome time together. It's designed to be a little less like the normal "venue" that people have come to




expect, and more like that secret bonus-stage out in the wild where you can jump into and try out a totally new and unique way to play and challenge yourself in FF14!"

The theme and layout is based on the actual real life arcade that used to be here in Melbourne, Australia which shared the same name. It's had the bonus of giving a ton of inspiration for the puzzles we've put together inside

Q:Which puzzle room was the most challenging to design and why?

A: By far the most challenging puzzle to design by a long shot was the newest 5-star difficulty build, The Time Machine. The planning and research stages for this took over 100 hours, with constant testing, and three pages of spreadsheets just to piece together the layout sequence!

The Time Machine isn't a normal housing build in any sense of the word, it's made to stretch the technical limits of the game engine and housing limitations to the absolute maximum and take advantage of really specific quirks in the game to cause all kinds of weird interactionsanimated furniture that moves on its own, the positions of items shifting and resetting, teleporting you insane distances within a single jump, there's so much tech used together to make this one happen!

Q: Are you looking to expand into other type of games? If so what kinds?

A: We are absolutely thinking about trying out some more videogame inspired builds! Although we have a ton fun with the arcade theme, we try to not limit ourselves too hard and have other

fun ideas on display too. Most puzzle builds are never really planned out and just sort of happen by stroke of inspiration... so depending if we see a game or idea that hits the spot, expect to see much more of it coming up in the future! Our most recent puzzle by Emileigh is a giant Pinball Machine which is a ton of fun, and we also have a Cinema inspired puzzle to play now too!

Q: What do you hope to achieve with "Game" as far as the FFXIV communities go?

A: The goal of Galactic Circus is to really bring a new way to have fun in the game and to inspire people who may have never seen anything like it before to come try it out and maybe even make a puzzle of their own. Our international community (Strange Housing) has collectively built over 600 puzzles together, so <GAME> truly is only the tip of the iceberg! There's a whole world of jumping out there and we even have sister hubs here on NA itself! Check out "Orbit" or "Space Camp" just to name a few.

Q:What can we look forward to in the future with "Game"?

A: In the future, expect a ton more crazy puzzles! There are so many ideas we have on mind, and a ton of new puzzle builders with unique inspiration planning to bring their style to the hub. We're always looking to innovate and create new techniques and ideas to apply and take our builds to the next level, and our research is far custom made original rooms (b). from finished. Please look forward to it!

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


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
